



OBEYING GOD I

The cardinal principle in human relation is obedience. The moment this principle is abridged, all communication becomes corrupted. Confusion sets in, and crisis looms. Proper actions cease and suspicion reigns. Everybody is uncomfortable and problems begin to develop. (Gen. 11:1-9).
